Did you know

- The Club recently purchased a new Kubota UTV. Our old UTV was sold a couple of years ago as it had reached the end of its useful life. When the Club did not own a UTV, most of the tasks performed were being done by borrowing member UTV's. Over \$7,300 was earmarked towards the purchase of the UTV from sales of the former UTV, old trap machines and other unused equipment. A portion of that money was used for a down payment and the rest was financed at zero percent for 36-months
- The Club now has a dumpster for recycling that replaces the grey "cardboard trailer". This will simplify the process of cardboard recycling for our volunteers and the dumpster can also be used for other recycling including plastic bottles, cans, etc.
