# Grant Update - Heated & Lighted 5-Stand Building

In July 2024 WS&TC applied for a Grant with the DNR to construct a Heated 5-Stand Building with Exterior Lighting. On January 14<sup>th</sup>, the DNR indicated that this project has been tentatively selected to receive a grant.

Over the next several months the DNR will complete its federal compliance review and receive final approval by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (among other things). It is considered tentative until all approvals have occurred. The DNR hopes to have a signed grant agreement to WS&TC by September 2025.
