Youth Trap Program – Register February 24, 2026

Each spring, our club provides a trap shooting program for Wausau area youth in grades 6-12. Students compete based on age and experience level virtually with the 10-team Great Northern Trap Conference.

All practice and league shooting is done at WS&TC, and a state-wide shoot is held at the Wisconsin Trapshooting Association Homegrounds in Nekoosa. The program is held at the club on Sundays from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm from March 15 through May 17.

The program is governed by the Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP), which provides certified coaches and nationwide clay target competitions. Target fees, ammunition, and safety equipment are included. Student athletes are encouraged to bring their own 12 or 20-gauge shotgun; otherwise, guns will be provided.

The Registration Fee is \$250. Registration/Orientation will be held on Tuesday, February 24th at the clubhouse. Please arrive anytime between 5:30 pm and 7:00 pm.

Badger State Games WINTER Trap Shooting Competition March 14, 2026!

Wausau Skeet & Trap Club is once again hosting the TRAP SHOOTING event for Badger State Games! After being recruited to host in 2022, this will be our 5th year welcoming participants to a Winter and Summer competition.

The entry fee ranges from \$50-\$65 depending on when you register.

- The early registration rate is \$50 when received by 2-1-26.
- The \$55 registration rate applies from 2-2-26 to 2-28-26.
- The onsite registration price is \$65.

Each hour 15 shooters (pre-registered) will take their position on their field; additionally, up to 5 on-site registrants can be accommodated. The 3:00 squad time is limited to 15 shooters who register in advance, as this helps us tally the results in a timely manner.

You will shoot the 100 targets from one field. Do you have a 'favorite' field to shoot on? New this year – you will be able to select your field on the registration form; first come first served. The first squad goes out at 9 am; the last one at 3:00. After the final squad shoots and scores are finalized, recognition and awards follow.

If you are with a group and want to shoot together (on the same field), after registering for the same time, send me your names and we will do our best to squad your group together.

Make your plans and register early so you can choose the best time for your squad!
